On October 23, 2021, the Crocker Police Department participated in the DEA National Prescription Take Back program. This led to approximately 130lbs of prescription medications being turned into the DEA for proper disposal. The Crocker Police have participated in this program for five years and will continue to do so as it is a safe and secure method for disposing of medications. There remains a prescription drop box at Crocker City Hall that is accessible during business hours. It is a red container that is the same as a mailbox you would drop mail into. You can simply drop the medications through the slot, and it is completely anonymous.

With the onset of colder weather, we want to remind you that if you have outdoor pets, please provide them adequate shelter with the means to keep warm. Place a blanket or straw for them as they need something warm to lay in. Remember to check their water daily as it can freeze and even though the temperatures are colder your pets still need water.

Recipe of the Month

Cranberry Bundt Cake

Ingredients

3/4 cup butter, softened

1-1/2 cups sugar

3 large eggs

1-1/2 teaspoons almond extract

3 cups all-purpose flour

1-1/2 teaspoons baking powder

1-1/2 teaspoons baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

1-1/2 cups sour cream

1 can (14 ounces) whole-berry cranberry sauce

1/2 cup finely chopped pecans

ICING:

3/4 cup confectioners' sugar

4-1/2 teaspoons water

1/2 teaspoon almond extract

Directions

1. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Stir in extract. Combine the flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt; add to the creamed mixture alternately with sour cream, beating well after each addition.
2. Spoon a third of the batter into a greased and floured 10-in. fluted tube pan. Top with a third of the cranberry sauce. Repeat layers twice. Sprinkle with pecans.
3. Bake at 350° for 65-70 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack. Combine icing ingredients until smooth; drizzle over warm cake.
