

AN ORDINANCE REVISING BOUNDARIES AND NUMBER OF WARDS  
WITHIN CITY LIMITS; FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING  
CONFLICTING ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crocker as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Crocker is hereby divided into two wards, to be known as Ward No. 1 and as Ward No. 2.

SECTION 2. That Ward No. 1 shall encompass and include all of the territory within the City Limits of the City of Crocker (as the city limits now exist and as they may exist in the future) which is West of the centerline of the main track of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad and North of Tenth Street and which is East of the centerline of the main track of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad and North of Mark Street.

SECTION 3. That Ward No. 2 shall encompass and include all of the territory within the City Limits of the City of Crocker (as the city limits now exist and as they may exist in the future) which is West of the centerline of the main track of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad and South of Tenth Street and which is East of the centerline of the main track of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad and South of Mark Street.

SECTION 4. That the persons now serving as aldermen from Ward No. 1 shall continue to serve as aldermen from Ward No. 1 (as revised by this ordinance) until their term of office expires.

SECTION 5. That the persons now serving as aldermen from Ward No. 2 shall continue to serve as aldermen from Ward No. 2 (as revised by this ordinance) until their term of office expires.

SECTION 6. That a vacancy now exists in the office of alderman from Ward No. 3 (as such ward previously existed) by reason of the failure of any person to be elected and to qualify to serve as such, and that no election shall be held to fill such vacancy by reason of the fact that there shall no longer be a Ward No. 3.

SECTION 7. That the person now serving as aldermen from Ward No. 3 shall continue to serve as a member of the Board of Aldermen until his term of office expires.
